


Thank you for feedback – it helps us develop.

We had mixed feedback about the format:


This year we had a lecture weekly for four weeks and then a half day. People varied how they watched to fit in with life and work.

We asked about you:


For 24% it was their first course. 51% had attended on 2 – 3 occasions previously, 10% had attended more than 10 times!

17% of people funded the course themselves and for 10% it was harder than normal to identify funding. 54% found it about the same as usual.

We asked you to feedback on your learning: Looking at what you learnt from our 8 speakers




We asked you to feedback on the teaching: You said
