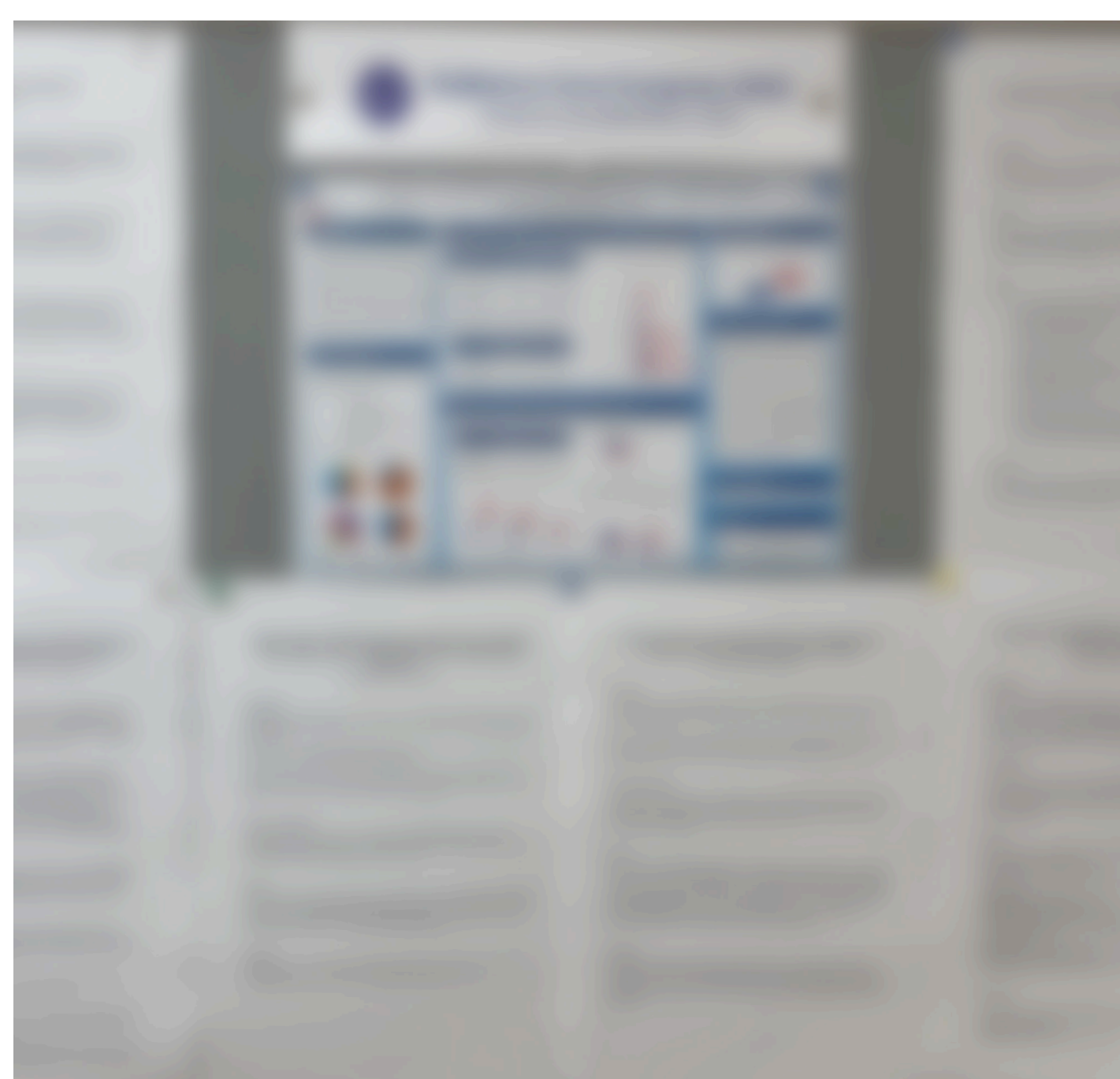

This course will provide essential insights and practical tools to help you support patients and families affected by trauma in end-of-life care settings.

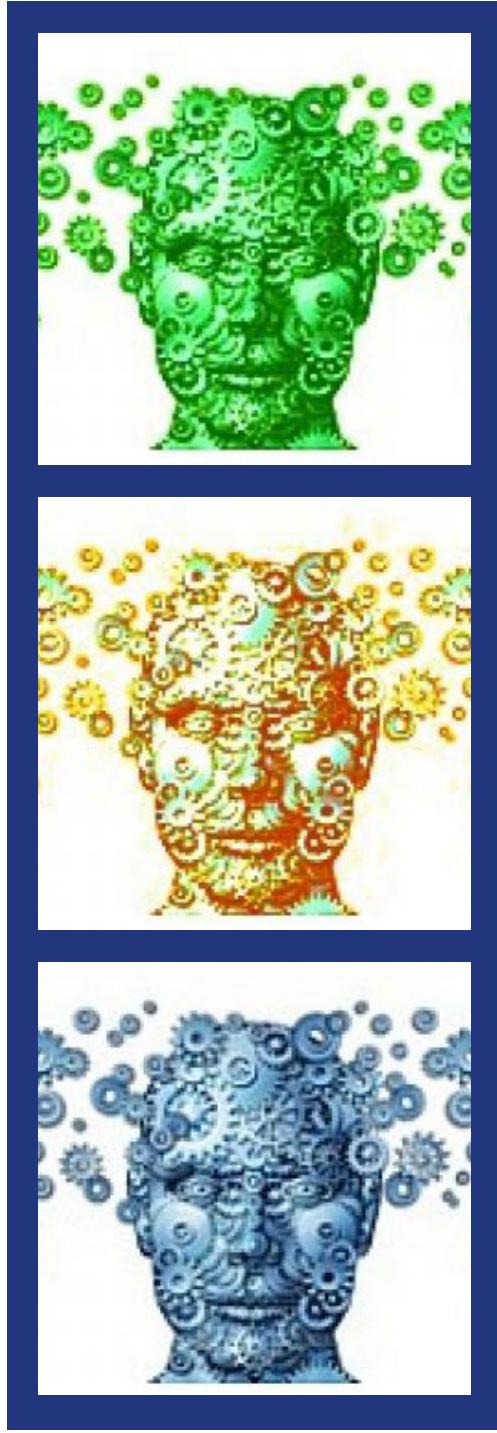


Palliative Care Congress 2025

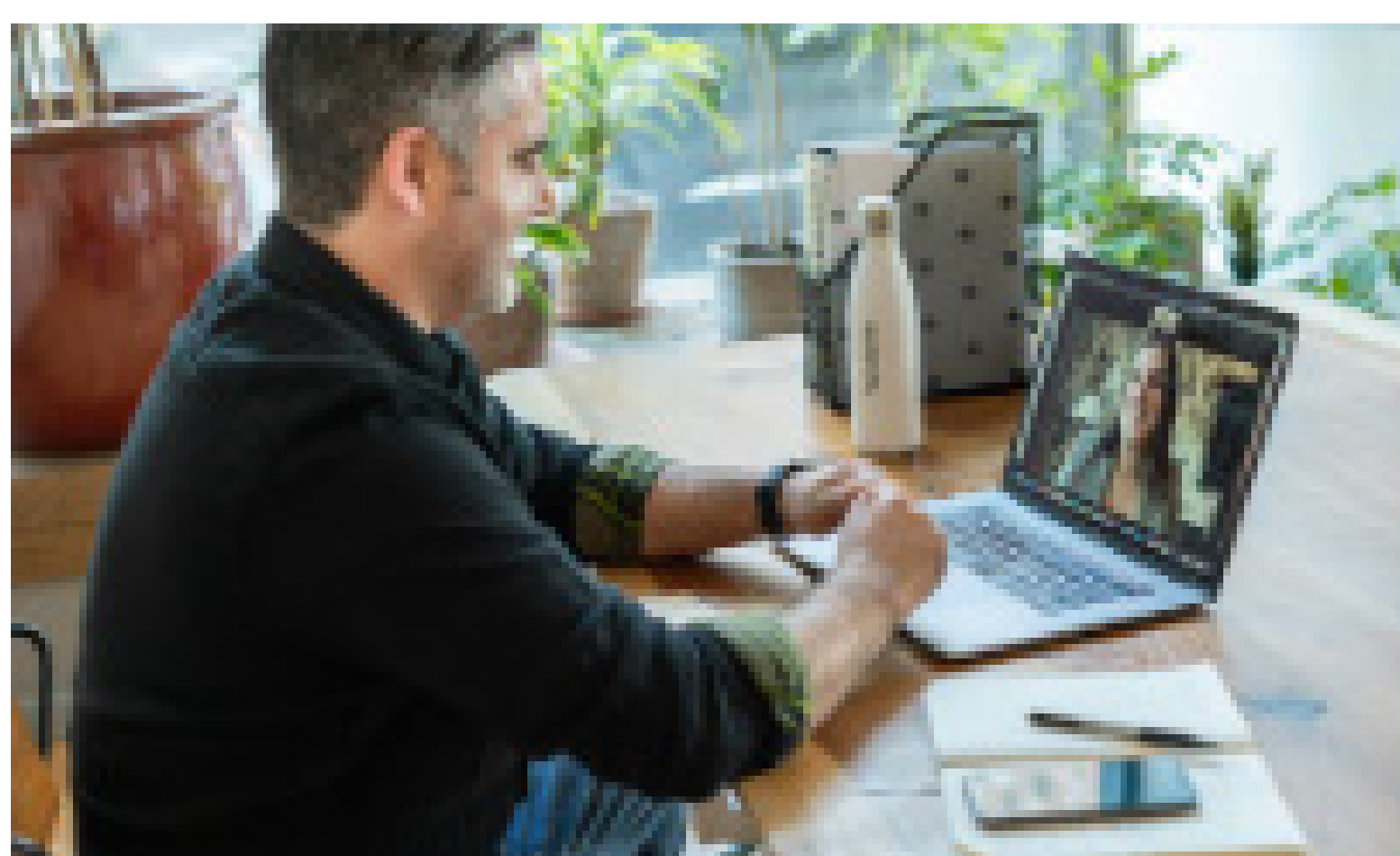
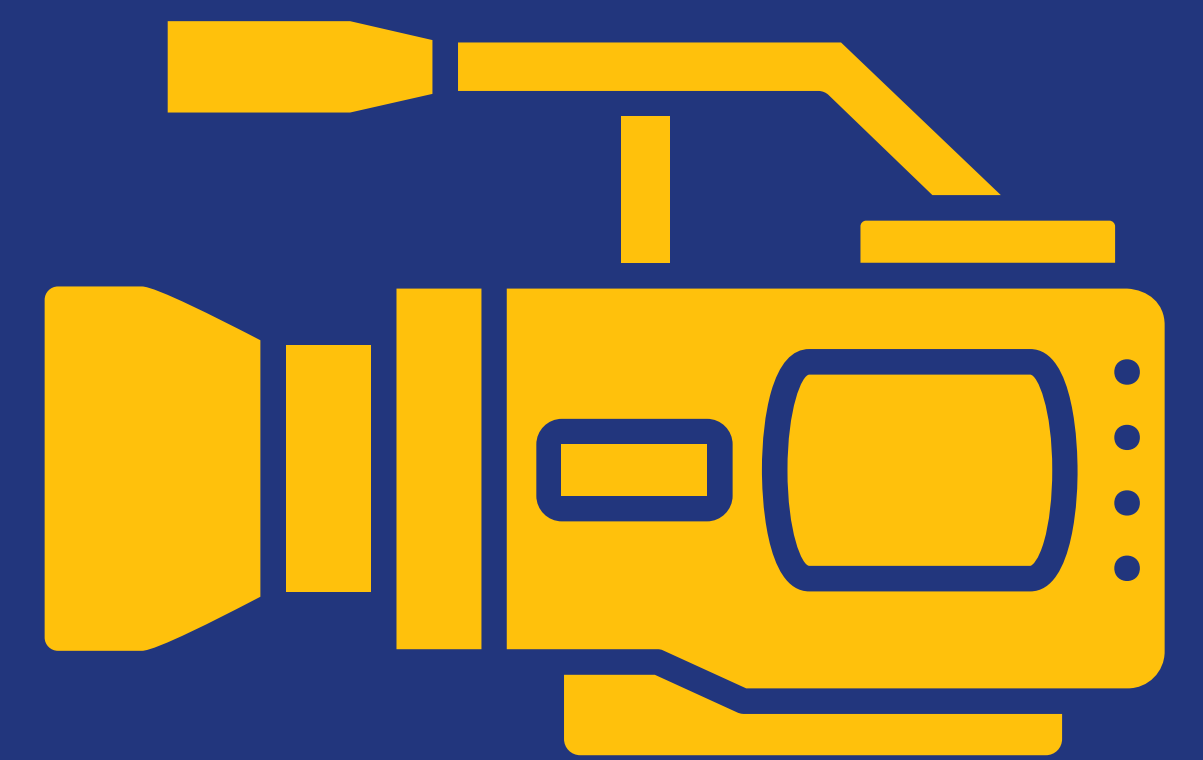


General Medicine Recordings Now Available

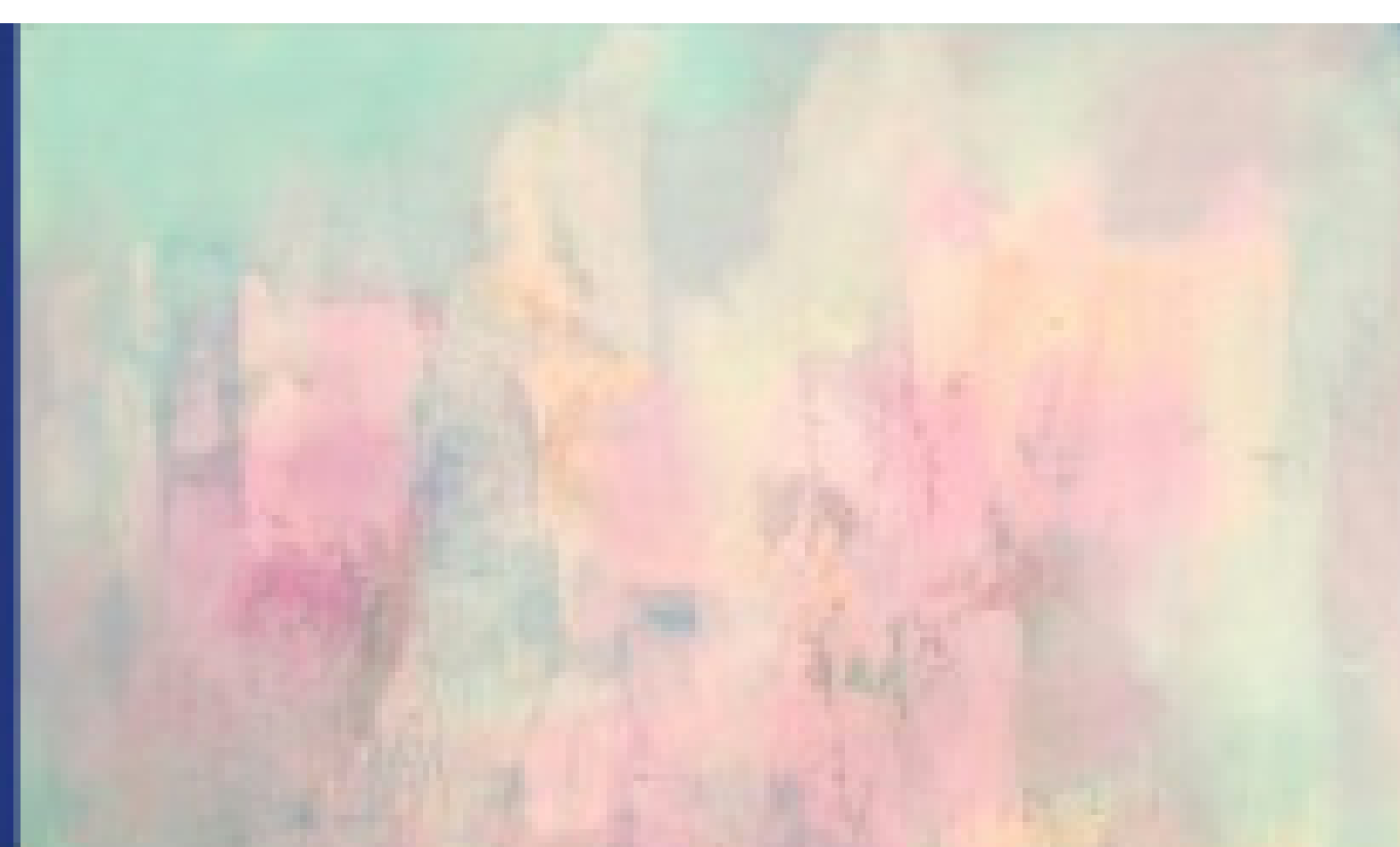
The recorded 2024 General Medicine for Palliative Care course is designed to help doctors working in palliative medicine stay up to date.
