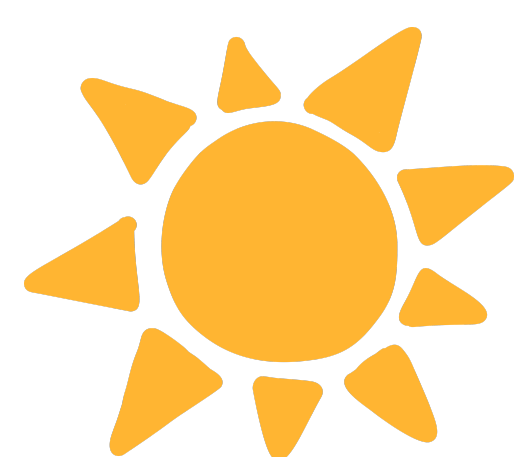
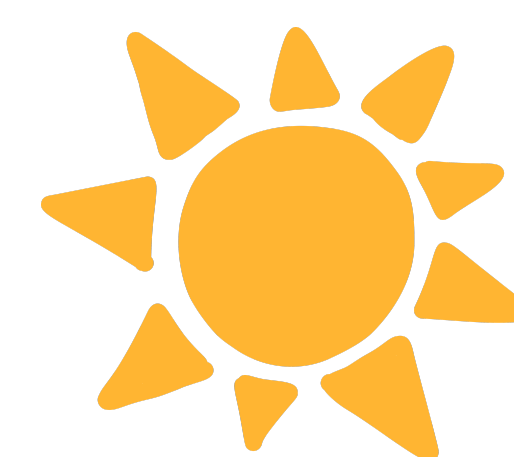

Trauma Informed Care

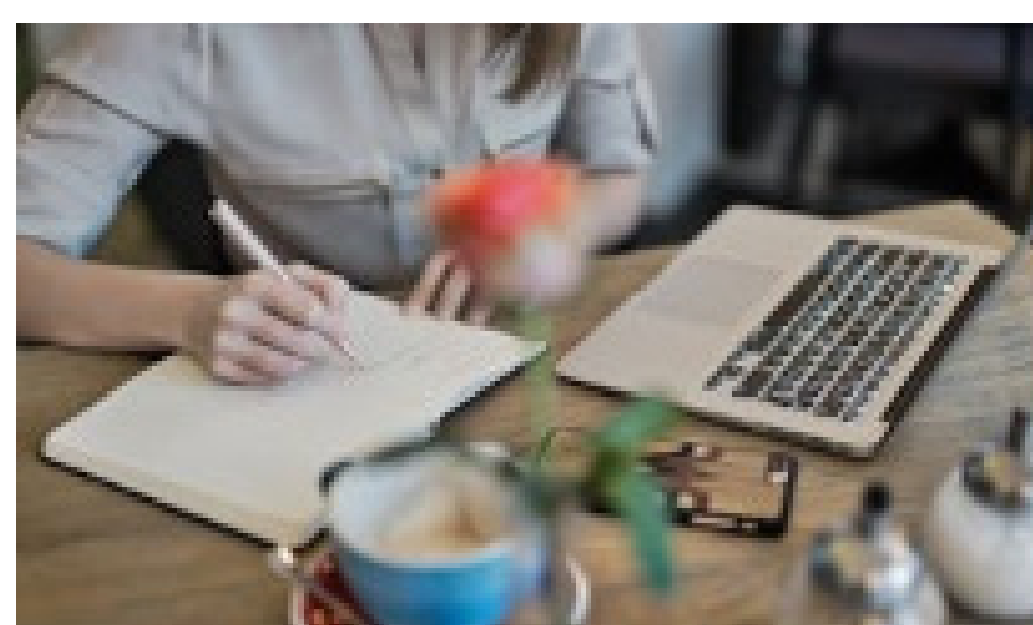
